





Apples & Pears

Apples - We continue to have Apples from Washington and the quality is strong. Catch the last local Apples such as Ambrosia and MacIntosh before the season finishes.

Pears - Fresh shipments have arrived from Argentina and South Africa. Quality and flavour is excellent! Contact your sales representative for more details.

Kiwi

New Zealand Gold and Chilean green Kiwi has arrived! Quality is very good! Available in bulk or clamshell. Contact your sales representative for details.

Cherries

California season has finished up and we have is fully transitioned to the Washington region.

Avocados

Deals will be in larger sizes, 32s, 36s and 40s for the next 2 weeks. This is Jalisco new crop fruit so the ripening process will take longer if done naturally. Remember that we can custom ripen any size. 16s Ripe Avocados are always in inventory.

Papaya

Papaya is currently being sourced from Guatemala. We are now offering ripening program for Papaya to tailor to customers' preference. For further details, please contact your sales representative.

Bananas & Plantains

Bananas are in great supply! All SKUs are offered at the best quality. Port delays are still happening which might affect fruit availability and scheduling in the future. We offering special pricing on 13X3lb conventional bag SKU. Plantains are also in great condition and supply.

Mangoes

Mexican Tommy season is towards the last batch. We are currently carrying HADEN/ KENT or TOMMY and select to offer the best quality Mango at the market. All varieties have the best pricing so far for this season!

Melons

Cantaloupe & Honeydew: We've now started receiving supplies from Arizona with fair FOB pricing. With the tariffs and logistics, the landed cost is fairly high. Also available now, Golden Hami Melons with large sizing, sweet fruit.

Pineapples

Pineapple supply is tight and will stay in limited supply until later July. 7ct conventional will be harder to find so reach out to your sales representative ASAP to reserve yours!

Grapes

Green Grapes - We're starting to see better supplies coming out of Mexico and the market is starting to move down in price as more varieties and volume become available. The biggest growers indicate that there is plenty of fruit hanging and we could see prices drop. Next week will feature Early Sweets, Superiors and Sugarones and Cotton Candy Grapes!

Black Grapes - Mexican Black Grapes now available in the Summer Royal variety. Sizing and brix are optimal, market is steady with supply for the next few weeks.

Red Grapes - Even with Flame crop being damaged by rain, there's better availability of red grapes than green. We have pockets of very nice Flames. We've been waiting for Sweet Celebrations to start crossing, but growers are waiting on sugar. Early Flames from Arvin, California are about 3 weeks away. Mexican marketers may only have 4 weeks left to sell what's still hanging. Next week will feature Flames and Sweet Celebrations.

Strawberries

Good volume is expected throughout the next few weeks as Mexico and California are pushing out good volume.

Watermelon

The market is flooded with US product due to the increase in Mexican acreage. Quality is fair and we could see the market increase as Georgia is forecasted to have less volume. Tariffs are still in effect for US products.

Blackberries

The Mexican crop is winding down as the transition begins. We will see Georgian berries starting in the next couple weeks, which should alleviate supply issues.

Clementines Easy Peelers

We just have RSA fruit for now. US, Maroc & Israel are all done. Early Clementines are in and demand is exceeding supply which is typical for this time of year. Book ahead.

Grapefruit

First of the season RSA have arrived in small volumes. Logistical delays have us a little behind right now. We still have a few California around and quality is good on everything.

Stone Fruit

California is in full swing and quality is good. Fruit is sizing up! Look for Black Plums, Apricots, Donut Peaches, Bulk Yellow and white Nectarines. Yellow and White Peaches will also be available to order. New arrivals of California Quince size 28/30ct will be available early next week!

Raspberries

Currently Mexican crops are winding down. This last crop before moving to a different region. Pricing is favourable and quality is fair.

Pomegranates

Fresh arrivals due from Peru, sizes range from 5-12. "Wonderful" is the most well-known exported variety of Pomegranate, famous for its deliciously sweet taste and attractive red colour.

Blueberries

Regions have moved from Florida to Georgia and North Carolina. BC Blueberries are scheduled to be in good volume mid-July. Mexican product is still flowing at a steady rate.

Oranges

Bloods (Sanguinelli's) are almost done, stay ahead if you need

Cara Cara are finished for the season, and a great season it was!

Navels from California have about 3 more weeks to go and prices are strong. We should have RSA by the end of the month.

Maroc Lates are still coming and they move fast so book ahead.

Egyptian Valencias are here for juicing. Book them if you need them as they could run out anytime.

Lemons & Limes

Lemon market appears to have strengthened globally with all shipping points raising prices. Strong demands in Europe are putting pressure on the South African deal. where they have seen some growing issues in some areas. So far, our fruit that has arrived has been very nice but moving very quickly. Stay ahead with your sales rep to avoid disappointment. We will continue to carry US, RSA and a Chilean program for later in the season.

Lime market has gotten much easier in the past few weeks. Look for promo deals to go with your Coronas.:)
