Apples & Pears

Apples - The Apples are coming from Washington and the quality is strong. Catch the last local Apples such as Ambrosia and MacIntosh before the season finishes.

Pears - New shipments have arrived from Argentina and South Africa. Quality and flavour is high tier! Contact your sales representative for more details.

Kiwi

New Zealand Gold and Chilean green Kiwi has arrived! The quality is excellent! Available in bulk and/or clamshell. Contact your sales representative for details.

Cherries

Washington and BC cherries are in full swing. Quality and flavour is at its best.



Avocados

Mangoes

Mexican Tommy season is winding down. We are currently carrying HADEN/ KENT or TOMMY to select to offer best quality mango at the market. We now have air-flown ready to eat fancy KENT 12ct (5.5kg) from Mexico. All varieties have the best pricing so far for this summer!

Melons

Cantaloupe & Honeydew: Regions will be moving up again into California as we finish up with Arizona. Expect the sizing to be large, as crown picking will commence starting July.

Pineapples

Pineapple supply is tight and will stay in limited supply until later July. 7ct conventional will be harder to find so reach out to your sales representative ASAP to reserve yours!

Grapes

Green Grapes - We're starting to see better supplies coming out of Mexico and the market is starting to move down in price as more varieties and volume become available. The biggest growers indicate that there is plenty of fruit hanging and we could see prices drop. Next week features Early Sweets, Superiors and Sugarones and Cotton Candy Grapes!

Black Grapes - Mexican Black Grapes now available in the Summer Royal variety. Sizing and brix are optimal, market is steady with supply for the next few weeks.

Red Grapes - Even with Flame crop being damaged by rain, there's better availability of red grapes than green. We've been waiting for Sweet Celebrations to start crossing, but growers are waiting on sugar. Early Flames from Arvin, California are about 3 weeks away. Mexican marketers may only have 4 weeks left to sell what's still hanging. Next week will feature Flames and Sweet Celebrations.

Strawberries

Strawberries will increase in price slightly for the beginning of July due to 2 long weekends in the US & Canada, but will be back down again once weather permits.

Watermelon

Watermelon sizing is large due to slow business, so Melons are sitting longer than planned. 60ct and smaller will be gapping until a larger crop has been picked through.

Blackberries

The Mexican crop is winding down as the transition begins. We will see Georgian berries starting in the next couple weeks, which should alleviate supply issues.

Clementines Easy Peelers

This week we have arrivals from Argentina (Nova variety) and South Africa (Nova & Clemenules). The market is still fairly tight but supplies seem to be meeting demands.

Grapefruit

We have our last California load in size 48's, nice clean fruit. We also have our first of the season RSA from Dole with our first Sunkist due in this week as well. Pricing is steady, quality is excellent.

Stone Fruit

California is in full swing and quality is good. Fruit is sizing up! Look for Black Plums, Apricots, Donut Peaches, Bulk Yellow and white Nectarines. Yellow and White Peaches will also be available to order. New arrivals of California Quince size 28/30ct will be available early next week!

Raspberries

Currently Mexican crops are winding down. This last crop before moving to a different region. Pricing is favourable and quality is fair.

Pomegranates

Fresh arrivals due from Peru, sizes range from 5-12. Famous for its deliciously sweet taste and attractive red colour "Wonderful" is the most well-known exported variety of Pomegranate.

Blueberries

Blueberries will finally transition to BC over the next week. The market price is set to be elevated but will shortly shift to promo volumes.

Oranges

We probably have 2 more weeks to go with US Late Lanes, no size, 72's are the biggest we can get right now other than the odd pallet of 56 & larger, Maroc Lates are still in stock but expect them to be done in a week or two, RSA has begun to arrive in all sizes. We have display cartons from Sunkist in 40/45/50/55's and telescopic boxes in sizes 48 through 105. See your sales rep for promo pricing. We can do bags as you need and in the size that you need.

Lemons & Limes

Lemon market looks like it will be difficult most of the summer

RSA fruit is tight and demands from Europe are too enticing for the South Africans. We will have weekly supplies but not what was booked due to logistic issues.

Argentina fruit is in the market. We still have some US arrivals, and we started shipping Chilean this week too. Look for those arrivals by the end of July.

Limes are coming from both Mexico and Honduras. Pricing is steady and quality has been very nice from both locales



Hot House Peppers

The Local Canadian pepper production had dropped significantly due to weather conditions. The shortage could remain in the next few weeks.

Peppers

Peppers are fully into North Carolina. Supply is strong but weather could affect supply. Quality is amazing! Prices are reasonable.

Cauliflower

US market is steady. We'll have Freshkist 12s and Andy Boy 9s. Quality is looking good!

Broccoli

The US market is seemingly active. The Andy Boy bunch of broccoli is arriving regularly. Local Ontario crowns are now available daily.

Green Beans

We are currently sourcing from North Carolina which is winding down. Local beans are starting in about in 10 days.

Corn

Fresh Bi colour and Yellow corn is now arriving regularly from Georgia. Quality is good!
