Apples & Pears

Grapes

Green Grapes - There were plenty of Autumn Kings still hanging, but only percentages of them were covered, so we will continue to see a decline in volumes through November. There are reasonable volumes in cold storage, but demand for green grapes remains strong, so we will see the spot market tick higher. Peru has set a good crop, and we will start to see volumes arriving from Piura in mid-November and then steady volumes form Ica in December. Arriving next week Sweet globes and Autumn kings.

Black Grapes - Autumn Royals quality looks good and volume is steady.

Red Grapes - Scarlett Royals, Krissy, and Allison are the main varieties available with Sweet Celebration harvests now getting underway. Shippers are still pushing out aggressive spot pricing (Large size primarily) to keep red seedless moving, Green seedless continues to outpace red. Next week will feature Allisons, Jack Salutes and Scarlet Reds.

Strawberries

The market is in a demandexceeds-supply situation. Recent rain impacted yields, causing a price spike. Mexican product with limited supplies with unfavorable weather condition. Florida expected to start by mid-end November with light volume.

Blueberries

The market is moving steadily. Stocks are abundant out of all regions, Peru, Argentina, Mexico. Quality is very good. Berries are plump and sweet.

Clementines Easy Peelers

We have some Chilean fruit left now that we can sell in bulk or in bags as you wish. We also have the Royal Queen Mandarin with good sizing. We also have Peruvian Honey Murcotts available.

Grapefruit

We have finished with all of our offshore programs and we now have Florida fruit in. The grapefruit are the Rubies which are very nice. These are from the CUPS program and they are almost blemish free prices are higher than regular Florida grapefruit.

Larger fruit however have been slow and we have promo prices on them. Bags are available for your programs. We have Valencias from Argentina as well Florida has started but they are peaking very small and prices are not competitive to what South America or South Africa is.

Lemons & Limes

Lemons: We still have fresh arrivals coming in from South Africa and Chile, as well as weekly arrivals from the US. The market is easing up now. See your sales rep for promo pricing.

Limes: Persian limes from Mexico are coming in very nice and they too can be promoted. Sweet Limes have started. Our first arrival was this past week. Size is still a struggle peaking on Large with only a few Jumbo. Our next arrival will be this weekend.
