Grapes

Green Grapes - California Autumn Kings and Autumn Crisp are the predominant varieties left to ship. Many growers have stated that they can take their customers through December, but the reality is that good quality late fruit will be left in the hands of only a few select shippers. Many will be done by Thanksgiving, setting up a good start for importers with early Peruvian fruit. Demand for imports will certainly pick up steam, if quality on California fruit starts faltering.

Black Grapes - Autumn Royals quality looks good and volume is steady.

Red Grapes - We are seeing more inconsistent quality on California red seedless than on green. Certain varieties can take the rain better than others and many of the defects are not easily recognizable to packers in the field and tend to present themselves several days after packing. There are still very good supplies of quality fruit Scarlett Royals, Krissy, Allison.

Strawberries

The market is in a demandexceeds-supply situation. Recent rain impacted yields, causing a price spike. Mexican product with limited supplies with unfavorable weather condition. Florida expected to start by mid-end November with light volume.

Blueberries

The market is moving steadily. Stocks are abundant out of all regions, Peru, Argentina, Mexico. Quality is very good. Berries are plump and sweet.
