# **Grapes**

Green Grapes - East Coast retailers are showing more interest in imported green seedless, as California quality continues to run hot and cold. Although there are supplies of Peruvian green grapes on the East Coast, the volaumes are not nearly enough to support a full transition. Weekly shipments from Peru are still running behind last year's pace and that trend will continue well into December.

Black Grapes - California still has decent volume on Black Grapes – those will be transitioned to Peruvian fruit in the upcoming week.

Red Grapes - With 3 more days of rain expected in California this week, any remaining red grapes still hanging on the vines will certainly be impacted. Quality of remaining fruit in cold storage is inconsistent. Retailers will be keeping a very close eye on California quality. Currently, there are very limited volumes of imported red grapes on the East Coast, but we will see increased arrivals right after Thanksgiving.

### **Strawberries**

The market is escalating. Harvesting has been cancelled in California due to heavy rainfall. Florida supplies just started with light volume, Mexican supplies will help fill the void, but cannot meet full demand. Industry volume will not meet demand through the rest of this week in all growing regions.

### **Blueberries**

Markets are stable. Quality in Mexico's growing region has improved, increasing yields. Peruvian shipments with abundant supplies on the market.

### Clementines Easy Peelers

We will be starting this week with US Clementines from Sunkist. We are done with Chile and RSA clems, there are still a few Queens from South Africa in stock. California Minneolas will be starting around Christmas time or shortly after.
