Grapes

Green Grapes - Peruvian Green Grapes will be transitioning from Northern Piura to Ica(southern region) all indications it will be a good crop expect to see promotable volumes of all varieties by January 15th. Autumn Crisp from Ica have been delayed, but once we start seeing decent arrivals after the 1st week in January there will be a steady supply of this preferred green variety. Next week will feature Autumn Crisp and Sugar Crisps. Jumbo Ivories will coming in later next week.

Black Grapes - The Black Grape market is very tight due to vessel delays – there will be availability starting Sunday Dec 14th

Red Grapes - With only 6 million total boxes of Peruvian red seedless exported this season, the spot market has held firm through December. Green exports from Peru have topped 11 million, almost double that of red. This just continues to validate the idea that consumers have shown a preference for the new green seedless varieties. Next week will feature Jumbo Allisons, Jack Salutes and Jumbo Red Globe Grapes .

Strawberries

Expect tight supplies and high markets this week. Heavy rain has impacted production in Oxnard and Santa Maria, California. Quality is average, early signs of decay and bruising have been reported. but stocks will tighten and prices will climb.

Raspberries

Prices are steady. Mexican production is focused in the Baja region. Volume is high. Quality is very good.

Oranges

New this week - Blood Oranges are in. California navels have been excellent. You will see the small sizes get tight and there will be deals happening on 72's and larger. Juice oranges from Florida are in, color is light and prices are stable. Truck rates are pushing prices up. See your sales rep for deals on large fruit 48/56. Rains in California are affecting crops.

Grapefruit

We will continue with our "Rubies" program from Florida. Fruit is a little tight down there due to the fundraising they do at this time of year. Quality has been outstanding!!

Soft Tree

California **Persimmons** size 40-44 & 48/50VF will be available for next week – supply is good. Spanish Persimmons size 16's 22's and 6ct packs are now available quality looks good!

Pomegranates have transitioned to Egyptian size 7,8,9 & 10 quality is #1.

Stone Fruit

Angelino Plums have arrived 50/55 & 55/60 quality is good will be available for the next two weeks.

Blackberries

Prices are level. Stocks are abundant. Mexican quality is very good. Softness is an occasional issue.

Blueberries

The market is unchanged. Volume is high in Mexico. The Peruvian season is wrapping up. Production is now underway in Chile. Quality is very good.

Clementines Easy Peelers

We have been on full swing with Clementines from California. Quality has been typical for this piece of fruit. We have some stem and leaf fruit from Spain and we will start with Murcotts and or Nadorcotts just after Christmas. Autumn Honey Tangerines have been selling well. This is a short season, don't miss out. Next week we will be receiving Noble "King" fruit which is a Shiranhui from Florida.

Lemons & Limes

Lemons: Lemon market is stronger mostly due to trucks. Quality has been excellent but keep your purchasing tight and stay FRESH.

Limes: The lime market is strong, prices will be higher, stay ahead with your sales rep Sweet Limes have been moving well. We have Mammoth, Jumbo , and Large sizes

Carton and Mini watermelons are a little bit snug heading into the holiday season.

Limited local production due to less sunlight in daytime. Mexican and USA import to supply the market demand. Price remains stable.

Lettuce

Availability is increasing and Prices are coming down. Fresh loaf of Andy Boy Cellos expected in over the weekend. Contact your sales rep for more information.

Cucumbers

We have Mexico Cucumbers coming in. Prices are steady.
